League Information

- Instructional League

- League is designed for introduction to the game of basketball
- We do NOT keep score in this league
- We teach and require the kids to play a ZONE defense that stays inside the lane.
- Church Sponsored – This is sponsored by the Batesville First Church of the Nazarene (BNAZ). This event will include prayer and devotionals at halftime.
- NEW THIS YEAR – Practice and games will be on Sunday afternoons, Monday and Tuesdays.

- League Format

- We play 4 on 4 half court.
- The 4 defensive players must remain inside the basketball lane.
- Players are provided a game Jersey and an Award at the end of the season

- Practice Format

- We set up 4 stations and each team rotates through each station every 9-10 minutes.
- The 4 stations are Ball Handling, Defense, Dribbling, and Offense
- The training is kept simple and repetitive to teach basic skills.

- Game Format

- Games consist of four quarters, length of quarters is based on the number of players on a team.
- We rotate during every quarter to ensure every child plays at least once per quarter.
- We maintain a player log during the game to equalize playing time among all players

- Additional Information

- Limited to first 96 kids, all other kids will be placed on a wait list.
- Please call, send in, or drop your form at the church by **December 22nd**.
- Send in your payment with the form or bring your payment to the first practice.
- Based on the grade of your child, you can determine the date and time of practice.
- Kindergartener and 1st Graders will have their first practice at 6 pm Monday, Jan 2nd
- 2nd graders first practice is at 6 pm Tuesday, Jan 3rd
- Both groups practice Sunday, Jan 8th: K-1st grade at 2:00 pm, and 2nd grade at 3:30 pm.
- Games will begin on Monday, January 16th.
- There will be snacks and drinks available for purchase on game days.

- Volunteer Support Needed

- Coaches and Helpers – We need parents to volunteer to help manage the kids. Do not be intimidated. We show parents how to take them through the stations during practice, and how to set them up during games. Parents do not need to be basketball players, they just need to be able to line up the kids. The program will teach the kids through structure and repetition.
